## Queens sign three to fill 2009-10 roster

Flying Queens head coach Tory Bryant recently announced the addition of three new players to his roster for the 2009-2010 basketball season, including two junior transfers and two area freshmen.

"I'm excited about our signing class. The young ladies that we added fit well into our system and will provide depth and experience. They also will allow us to continue to play an up-tempo style of basketball."

A 6'2 post from Fontana, Calif., Briana Goss played last year at South Plains College in Levelland after a year at Trinity Valley Community College where her team advanced to the NJCAA National Tournament after winning both a conference and regional championship. Goss, a 2007 graduate of Etiwanda High School, had a season-high 22 points for the Lady Texans last year against Colby Community College.

inside," Bryant said. "She also has the ability to alter shots on the defensive end."

A member of the 2008 Class 3A State Champions and 2009 Class 4A Regional Qualifier, Aubrey Pedigo was a two-time All-District selection at Canyon High School. She averaged eight points and five rebounds during her final season as a Lady Eagle, and received MVP honors at the 2009 KIDS INC/TechTel Tournament of Champions and All-Tournament recognition at the 2009 Wichita Falls Fantasy of Lights Tourney. Predigo is a 6'2 post.

Libby Saultz was a member of the 2007-08 Class 5A Regional Quarterfinalist team from Amarillo High School and a 2008-09 First Team All-District 2-5A selection. A 5'11 forward, she averaged 12 points, seven rebounds and two assists during her senior season as a Lady Sandie. Saultz, who graduated in the top 1% of her senior class at AHS, was a 2009 Golden Spread All-Star and a TGCA Academic All-State selection.

"Aubrey will give us another strong and physical defensive presence inside. Libby gives us more size and depth on the perimeter and has a strong basketball IQ."

The Queens will also see the return of sophomore point guard Megan Coats to the lineup after a year's absence. As a freshman in 2007-08, Coats led the Sooner Athletic Conference in scoring, averaging more than 16 points per game. She also dished out nearly 4 assists per game.
